RE: **NV LIVE Changes Insurance Verification System to NV LIVE - Nevada Insurance Verification System (NevadaIVS)**

The current insurance reporting system for the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles is NV LIVE, which is implemented as part of our legacy computer system. We are in the midst of implementing a new system, which includes the reimplementation of NV LIVE utilizing the Nevada Insurance Verification System (NevadaIVS).

Action Required: To onboard with the new system, you need to go to www.NevadaIVS.com and click on the “Register” link in the menu and fill out the required fields. Registration is only available to insurance companies that are licensed in Nevada with the Division of Insurance. NevadaIVS.com is used for registration, account management, reporting, user management, and providing help to insurance companies. The NevadaIVS help desk will contact you after your registration is approved to begin the testing process. Please note, that NevadaIVS utilizes the Insurance Industry Committee on Motor Vehicle Administration (IICMVA) standards for insurance company reporting. **NRS 485.185, 485.313, and 485.314**

Key Dates for Insurance Companies:

January 31, 2024 – NevadaIVS is available to insurance companies for registration, testing, and production integration.

February 29, 2024 – Deadline for companies to register on the NevadaIVS website: www.NevadaIVS.com.

May 15, 2024 - Deadline for insurance companies to begin testing. Insurance companies must submit a test BOB (Book of Business) file to NevadaIVS and begin web services testing.

July 31, 2024 – Deadline for insurance companies to move to production with NevadaIVS, making their production web services available (if applicable) and begin weekly BOB data submissions.

Until all vehicle transactions have been moved to the new system, insurers must continue to report the monthly BOB to NV LIVE in the interim. Failure to meet these key dates and deadlines will result in non-compliance and will prohibit further reporting to the State.
